PURPOSE This policy has been adopted by the Board of Trustees to uniformly establish the requirements for a member to be considered for a scholarship for the purpose of participating in a Jewish related educational program or experience.

Congregation Tikkun Olam (CTO) offers a scholarship to the youth of CTO. The scholarship will be in the amount of \$500 or less per person.

Applicants for the CTO Scholarship must:

Be in high school or have just graduated.

Regularly participate in services and / or temple activities.

[Family] in good financial standing with CTO with annual dues paid in full.

Have the time to provide volunteer services to CTO.

Submit the attached application to the CTO Board. The application requires a short essay on what the applicant expects to gain from participation in this program.
